Are there any entry requirements?

Whilst 1-2 GCSEs at Grade C are desirable, a standard of literacy and numeracy supported by a general education equivalent to 4 GCSEs at a minimum Grade E, or equivalent qualifications, are usually required. Students **will** require GCSE Mathematics and English Language at Grade E or above.



What will I study?

You will learn by completing projects and assignments that are based on realistic workplace situations, activities and demands. You will focus on a particular area and develop a range of specialist skills and knowledge. The course is made up of 2 core units and up to 4 optional units.



All students take the 2 core units:

- Business Purpose
- and Business Organisation

You will also take 4 specialists units from:

- People in organisations
- Consumer Rights
- The Marketing Plan
- Managing Personal Finance
- Financial Forecasting Business



What skills will I learn? You will learn how to describe, analyse, interpret and evaluate business data and business scenarios. You will also learn role playing and Team work.

Assessment: How will I be assessed?

The course is assessed by means of assignments which are graded, and you will also receive an overall grade for the qualification.

What can I do after this course?

Successful students can progress onto a BTEC National Diploma or another advanced level course. Alternatively, students can gain employment in business organisations
