Are there any entry requirements?

A desire to work with young people to increase their social skills in an informal setting, whilst working within a close team building self confidence.

What will I study?

This course will provide an opportunity to develop and demonstrate skills and knowledge gained through volunteering. This qualification follows the same basic theme as the Level 2 but it goes deeper and requires more independent work.

You will study:

Carrying Out Own Volunteering Role
Team Working
Tackling Problems
Health and Safety for Volunteers*

Assessment: How will I be assessed?

You will produce a folder which is moderated at the end of the year. There is a practical placement in the school Social Space.

What can I do after this course?

This course is a foundation for any voluntary work you may carry out in the future. You could go on to do a Community and Youth Work Diploma at university.

Further details

There are CRB checks for this course. It runs on one full day per week. The qualification is the equivalent of 1 A-Level (63 UCAS points).
