Are there any entry requirements?

What would I need to enroll? - Math's and English grade C, a committed attitude to the courses, very good attendance, the ability to find your own models to work on in practical session. All candidates will be subject to interview and skills test, by course tutors.

Possible Hairdressing careers – Improver stylist, working towards senior stylist, salon based work, mobile, cruise ships, own business.

What will I study?

Is it a practical subject? - The course consists of practical based tasks in the salon working on models, theory, assignments and exams

How will I be taught? - You will carry out practical assessments on models and complete exams.

What units/modules will I study? - There are nine units to study, five mandatory units and four optional units, your tutor will discuss these with you at your interview.

How will I be assessed throughout the course? - There will be practical observations, oral questions and written exams throughout the course.
